

Important Information:

- Safety of injection has not been established in dog and cats less than 2.5 kg and in dogs under 2 months of age and cats under 4 months of age
- Safety of tablets has not been established in dogs & cats less than 2.5 kg and in dogs under 3 months of age and in cats under 4 months of age
- Safety of robenacoxib has not been established in breeding, pregnant or lactating cats and dogs
- Contraindicated for use in animals with gastrointestinal ulceration and in animals with a known hypersensitivity to robenacoxib
- Contraindicated for use concomitantly with corticosteroids or with other NSAIDs
- Onsior should not be given to animals with impaired hydration status, cardiac or renal insufficiency or decreased blood pressure
- Adverse reactions include mild and transient diarrhoea, soft to watery faeces and vomiting

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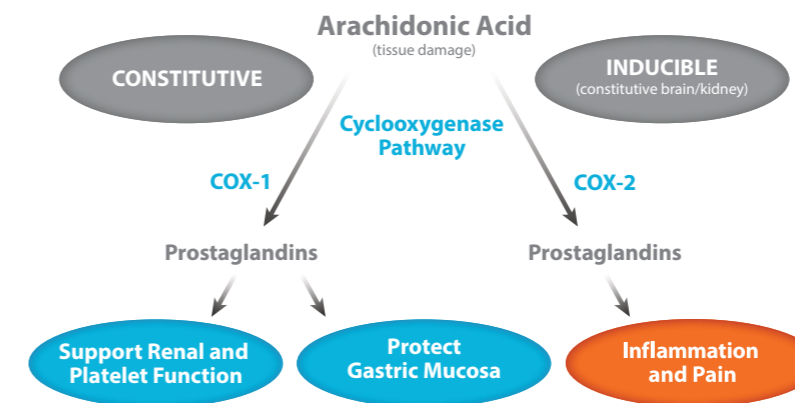

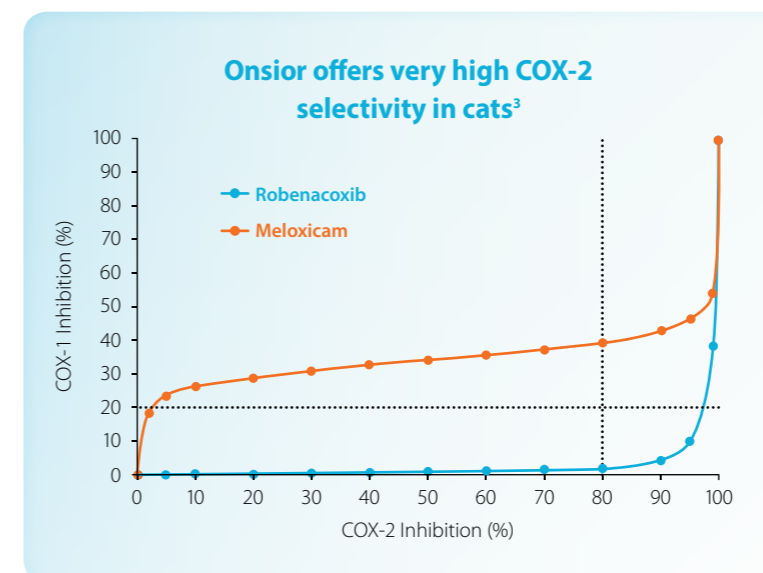


The COX Pathway:



What is a coxib?

- Coxibs are a group of NSAIDs that inhibit COX-2 hundreds of times more than COX-1
- Onsior is highly selective for COX-2 compared with COX-1. Onsior targets COX-2 to relieve pain and inflammation and spares COX-1 to protect gastrointestinal and platelet functions^{1,2}



Inhibition percentage of COX-2 and corresponding inhibition of COX-1 for a range of concentrations of robenacoxib and meloxicam in cats³.

- Available in both tablets and injectable form for both cats *and* dogs

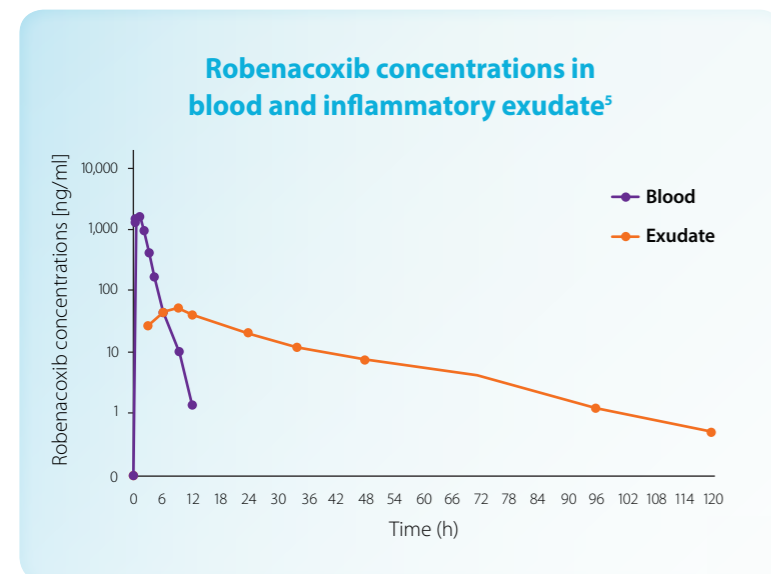

Onsior offers proven tissue selectivity

Onsior moves through the blood quickly, concentrating at the site of inflammation.



Carrageenan stimulated tissue cages in cats. 2 mg/kg robenacoxib SC.

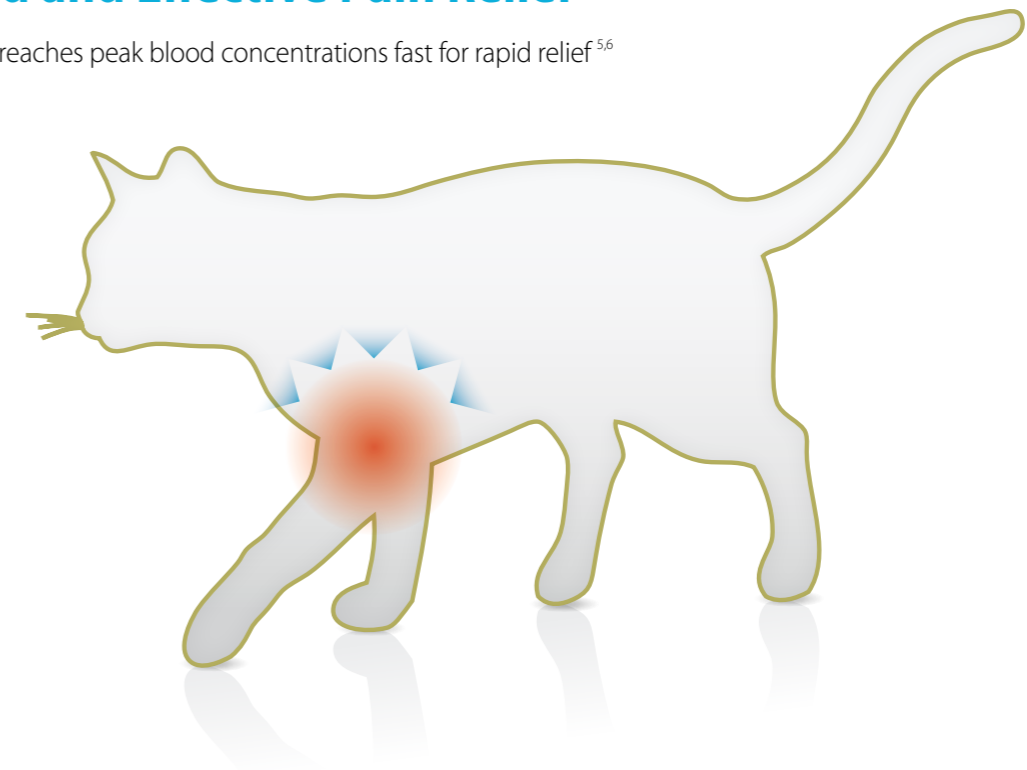
Onsior persists 3 times longer⁷ and at higher concentrations at sites of inflammation than in the blood.

Onsior is the only NSAID for cats and dogs that combines both the benefits of a coxib selectivity and the targeting of tissue selectivity



Rapid and Effective Pain Relief

- Onsior reaches peak blood concentrations fast for rapid relief^{5,6}

The convenience of a complete range and easy dosing regime



Onsior tablets: Easy once-daily dosing

- Flavoured tablets – yeast for cats and beef for dogs, well accepted by most cats *and* dogs
- Complete range that allows most cats *and* dogs to take only one tablet per day
- Simple dosing: target dose of 1mg/kg for both cats *and* dogs

Onsior solution for injection: Simple dosage regime for both cats *and* dogs

1 ml/10 kg body weight (2 mg/kg); administer subcutaneously before the start of surgery.

Onsior is approved for:

- Control of pain and inflammation associated with acute or chronic musculoskeletal disorders in cats. (Tablets)
- Control of pain and inflammation associated with chronic osteoarthritis in dogs. (Tablets)
- Perioperative use: Control of pain and inflammation associated with soft tissue surgery in cats and for the control of pain and inflammation associated with orthopaedic or soft tissue surgery in dogs
